

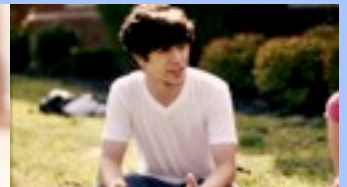
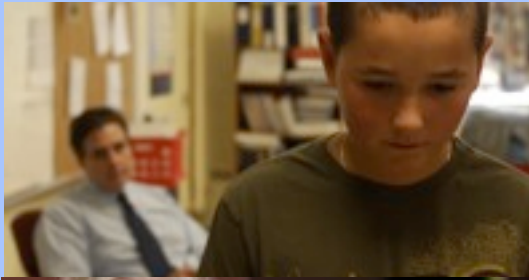
# LISTEN

.... a 15 minute dramatic movie created by middle school age youth to raise awareness about bullying and harassment. The film, produced at Project AWARE's Summer Film Institute, follows the stories of Freddie, Lily, Brooke and Elli each of whom is facing a personal challenge with peers, parents or teachers. The movie is based on the real life experiences of the youth creators.

**Listen** points out that youth voice and peer support is critical in dealing with disrespect, bullying, harassment and more. It also highlights how adults - often over-whelmed, anxious, or unaware - may not at first take seriously the issues these middle school students are facing.

By watching this movie, the creators hope that adults learn to really hear young people. For kids, that you keep telling adults, and each other, what's going on because there's always going to be someone who will **Listen**.

With a truly hopeful ending, the movie is intended to be used for educational purposes and to start a conversation about the importance of youth voice when addressing serious issues in school and at home.
